Extra Entry Requirements

Health care trusts will have the responsibility for selecting applicants for interview by the University. You must be a practitioner with opportunities to practice as an independent and/or supplementary prescriber following the successful completion of the programme.

You must also have:

valid registration on the appropriate professional register maintained by the professional bodies

appropriate experience in the area in which you will be prescribing

at least three years clinical experience (see nomination form)

the ability to study at Level 6

appropriate numeracy skills to undertake drug calculations

the ability to undertake clinical assessment and diagnose within their area of practice

a designated medical practitioner who meets the appropriate criteria and is willing to provide 12 days prescribing practice supervision. This will include supervision, opportunities, support and shadowing to develop competence in prescribing

the support and agreement from the prescribing lead and the employing organisation to allow your attendance and completion of all elements of the prescribing course

The programme centres on a tripartite commitment between you, LJMU and your employer. Your employer will be required to:

commit to ensuring protected practice time

the identification of a prescribing supervisor
